**Kansas Work Zone Crash Statistics in 2023**

<b>Total Crashes - 1,482</b>	<b>Property Damage Only - 1,118</b>
<b>Fatal Crashes - 6</b>	<b>Persons Killed - 9</b>
<b>Injury Crashes - 358</b>	<b>Persons Injured - 508</b>

Of the 9 people killed in work zone crashes, **all were motorists**

**Driver-related contributing circumstances** were recorded in **92** percent of all work zone crashes.

The **top 5 contributing circumstances** were inattention, followed too closely, improper lane change, right of way violations, and too fast for conditions.

**There were no adverse weather conditions** in **90** percent of work zone crashes.

**The crashes happened during daylight hours** in **76** percent of the crashes

**Kansas Work Zone Crash Statistics in 2022**

<b>Total Crashes - 1,249</b>	<b>Property Damage Only - 956</b>
<b>Fatal Crashes - 10</b>	<b>Persons Killed - 12</b>
<b>Injury Crashes - 283</b>	<b>Persons Injured - 383</b>

Of the 12 people killed in work zone crashes, **10 were motorists and 2 pedestrians.**

**Driver-related contributing circumstances** were recorded in **89** percent of all work zone crashes.

The **top 5 contributing circumstances** were inattention, followed too closely, too fast for conditions, right of way violation, and improper lane change.

**There were no adverse weather conditions** in **89** percent of work zone crashes.

**The crashes happened during daylight hours** in **73** percent of the crashes

**There were no adverse weather conditions** in **90** percent of work zone crashes.

**The crashes happened during daylight hours** in **78** percent of the crashes
