PROJECT OVERVIEW

This modernization project includes about 9 miles of shoulder widening and pavement rehabilitation along U.S. 160 between I-35 and Oxford. The improvements include extending several reinforced concrete box culverts, such as the Antelope Creek Bridge, and the replacement of the Arkansas River drainage bridge.

The project is currently in the IKE Construction Pipeline with construction planned to begin in the spring of 2025. It is anticipated to take two construction seasons. One lane of traffic will remain open throughout construction.

This project will require KDOT right-of-way acquisition and Sumner-Cowley Electric Cooperative (SCEC) utility relocations.
