PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Kansas Department of
Transportation will reconstruct
approximately 6 miles of K-23 in
Sheridan County. The project will
involve rebuilding the road into a 30foot paved surface with 3-foot turf
shoulders. In addition, the bridges over
Sand Creek and the South Fork
Solomon River will be replaced as
well. The open house will provide
information on construction timelines
and detour routes.

Work will occur over multiple construction seasons, with project work happening off the road in 2024. In March 2025, KDOT will close the highway entirely, and a state route detour using I-70, U.S. 83 and U.S. 24 will be in effect. KDOT expects to reopen the road in late fall 2025, and the entire project is expected to be completed in early 2026.
