

Hodgeman County Construction Coming Soon

PROJECT UPDATES

► K-156 Modernization in Hodgeman County | KA-5802-01

Overview: This IKE modernization project will rehabilitate the pavement and add shoulders on about 15 miles of K-156. The project corridor begins four miles west of the U.S. 283 junction in Jetmore, to 228 Road north of Hanston. Estimated construction cost is \$30.5 million.

Timeline: The construction letting is scheduled for the summer of 2024. Construction is expected to start before the end of 2024 and anticipated to take two construction seasons to complete. The majority of the K-156 project will be constructed under traffic with appropriate traffic control measures in place. A short-term closure of K-156 west of Jetmore will be required to flatten the existing profile and reconstruct the roadway.

K-156 Preservation in Hodgeman County | KA-7003-01

Overview: This preservation project will provide fresh pavement chip seal on 14 miles of K-156 from the Finney/Hodgeman county line east to Road 214.

Timeline: Construction is anticipated to begin in the summer of 2024. These improvements will occur under traffic with traffic control measures in place.


Bridge Preservation in Hodgeman County | KA-6781-01

Overview: Three bridge preservation projects will provide deck patching and fresh pavement overlay on the following:

- U.S. 283 over Buckner Creek (Bridge #029)
- K-156 over Buckner Creek (Bridge #030)
- U.S. 283 over Sawlog Creek (Bridge #070) in Ford County

Timeline: Construction is anticipated to begin in the summer of 2024. These improvements will occur under traffic with traffic control measures in place.
