**KDOT to host public information open house for
K-92 Centennial Bridge replacement project on Feb. 21**

The Kansas Department of Transportation, in coordination with the Missouri Department of Transportation, is hosting a public information open house for the K-92 Centennial Bridge replacement project on Tuesday, Feb. 21. The public is invited to attend the open house style meeting anytime between 4 p.m. and 7 p.m. at the **Riverfront Community Center, 123 S. Esplanade Street, Leavenworth, Kansas 66048**.

Replacement of the existing bridge is necessary as the structure is nearing the end of its useful life and major repairs to the steel structure will become more numerous and expensive over time. The project is expected to begin in 2026 and be completed in 2029.

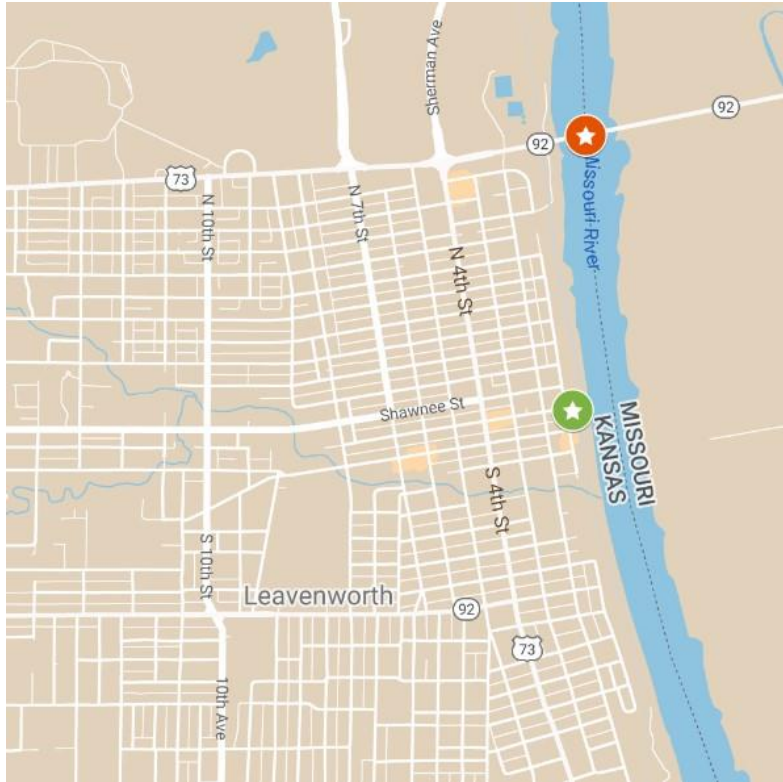
At the open house, attendees can learn about the project background, design process and work schedule. KDOT staff and project team members will be available to answer questions. There will not be a formal presentation.
