The traffic counts shown on this map represent estimates of the Annual Average Daily Traffic (AADT) for the year ending June 30, 1997. These AADT's are derived primarily from 24-hour traffic volumes recorded with portable, cumulative traffic counters. These short-term counts are adjusted for day of the week and seasonal variations using data from 98 continuous Automatic Traffic Recorders. An axle correction factor has been applied to each short-term count. A minimal amount of smoothing has been applied where large unexplained changes in traffic volumes were observed.

Heavy commercial volumes were derived from 24 or 48-hour visual or machine vehicle classification counts. These count locations are indicated by a check mark on the map. Heavy commercial AADT's for other locations are estimated from nearby counts on the same route or on other routes judged to have similar traffic characteristics.

Traffic counts on the new alignment of US-75 in south Topeka are included in green on the map indicating they were recorded in FY 1998.
