Kansas has several Travel Information Centers throughout the state. Friendly travel counselors will give you helpful state information and direct you to points of regional interest. Clean restrooms, drinking water, free coffee, picnic areas and pet exercise areas are also available at some centers.

The following centers are open year-round except New Year's Day, Easter, Thanksgiving and Christmas. Hours: 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. May 15 – Sept. 19, 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Sept. 16 – May 14.

Belle Plaine: 1-35 Kansas Turnpike at milepost 26. Accessible from both northbound and southbound lanes.
Goodland: 1-70 eastbound at milepost 7.

FOR THE CENTERED NORTH CENTRAL

- National Orphan Train Complex | Concordia** - Hear the heartfelt stories from the Orphan Train Movement that found new homes for 250,000 children from 1854-1929.
- Acorns Resort | Milford** - Arrive by land or water to relax on Milford Lake - Kansas' only full-service resort.
- Mural Movement | Clay Center** - It's always photo op time at these 24 (and counting!) vibrant murals throughout the city.
- Midwest Dream Car Collection | Manhattan** - With 65+ cars on display, it's one of the region's most prestigious automobile collections.
- World's Largest Ball of Twine | Cawker City** - Every Kansas road trip should include a pit stop at this national treasure.

FOR THE SEEKERS SOUTH CENTRAL

- Tanganika Wildlife Park | Goodland** - Chewbacca the Sloth and friends are waiting to meet you at the most interactive wildlife park in the country.
- Chaplin Nature Center | Arkansas City** - This 230-acre preserve is an oasis for trail hiking, wildlife viewing and bird watching.
- Museum of World Treasures | Wichita** - Watch history come alive, from Ancient Egypt and Ancient Greece to the founding of America and World War II.
- Cosmosphere | Hutchinson** - See the world's largest collection of Soviet and U.S. Space Race memorabilia outside of the Smithsonian.
- Salter House Museum | Argonia** - In 1887, Kansans elected the first woman mayor in the U.S. - visit her historic home.

FOR THE LEGENDARY SOUTHWEST

- M.T. Liggett Art Environment | Mullinville** - Immerse yourself in the works of one Kansas' most legendary grassroots artists. You'll find 600 hand-built signs, sculptures and whirligigs.
- Fort Larned National Historic Site | Larned** - The best preserved 1860's military post on the Santa Fe Trail.
- Keystone Gallery | Scott City** - See a 30-foot plesiosaurus that was excavated a few miles away.
- Boat Hill Museum | Dodge City** - Belly up to the bar for an old-fashioned sarsaparilla after being deputized in a Wild West city.
- Big Well Museum | Greensburg** - The world's largest hand-dug well is one of the eight wonders of Kansas.

FOR THE FREE SOUTHEAST

- Luther's BBQ | Fort Scott** - Home of the legendary beef flavored marshmallows. You're welcome.
- Elk City State Park | Independence** - Nestled between woodlands and prairie grasses, these 857 acres are an outdoor enthusiast's dream.
- Mine Creek Civil War Battlefield | Pleasanton** - The largest Civil War battle in Kansas was fought right here on this picturesque site.
- Dalton Defenders Museum | Coffeyville** - Retrace the final moments of the Dalton Gang's last ride, and meet the community that stopped them in their tracks.
- Historic Murals - Self-Guided Outdoor Tour | Oswego** - Take photos in front of all 11 murals. Grab a map at City Hall, the museum or visitor's center.
