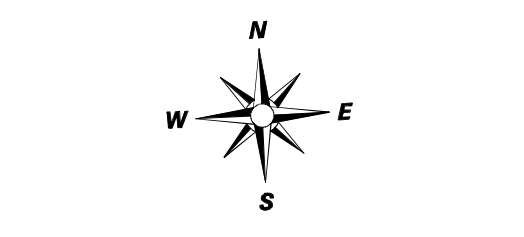

LAMBERT CONFORMAL CONIC PROJECTION

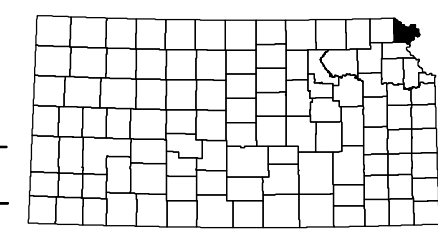
