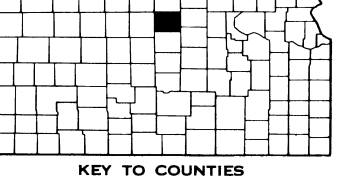


GENERAL HIGHWAY MAP MITCHELL COUNTY KANSAS
