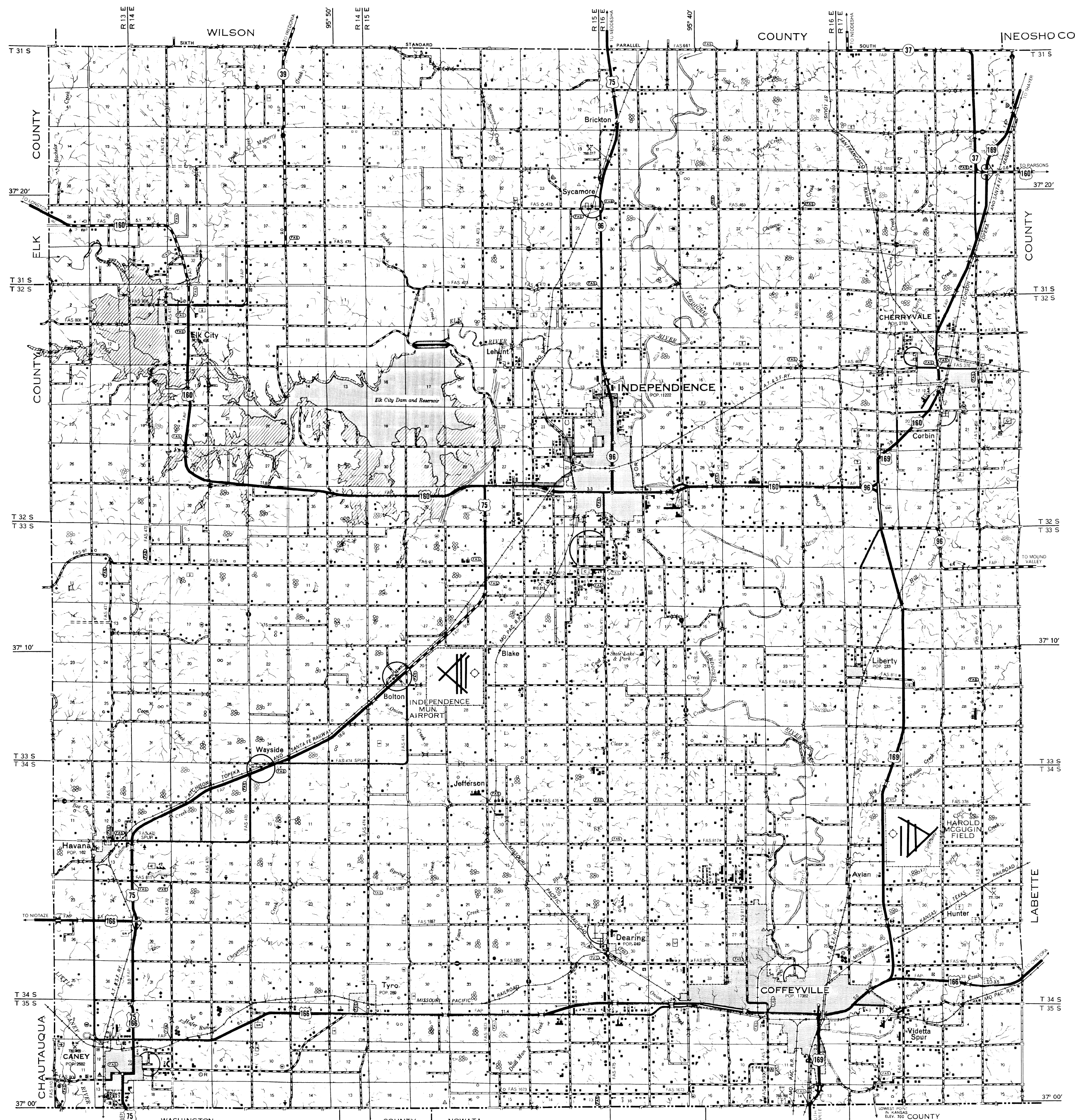

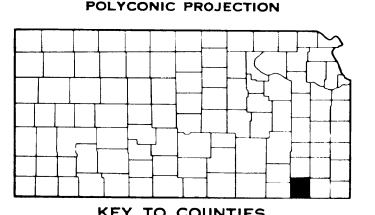


GENERAL HIGHWAY MAP

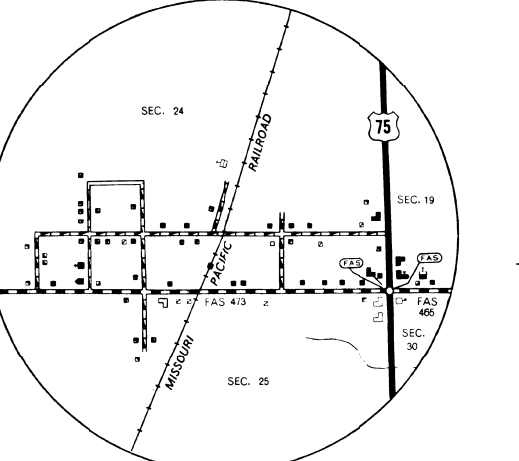

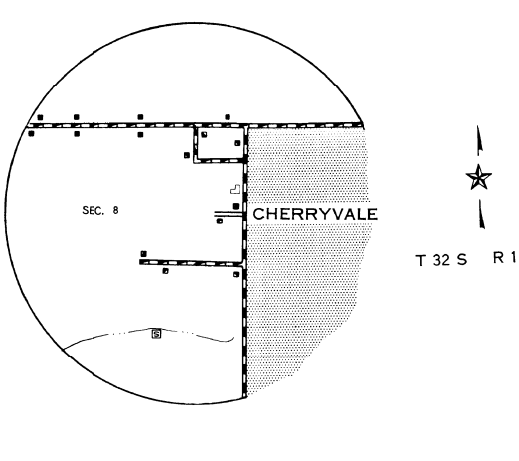

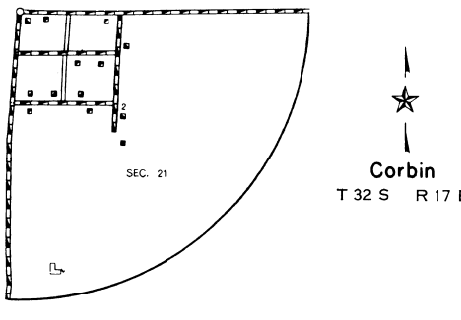

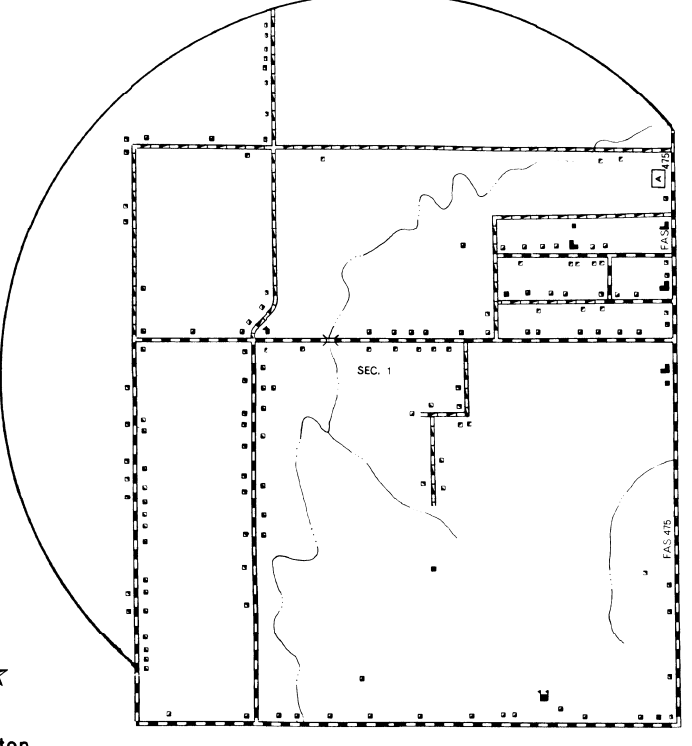

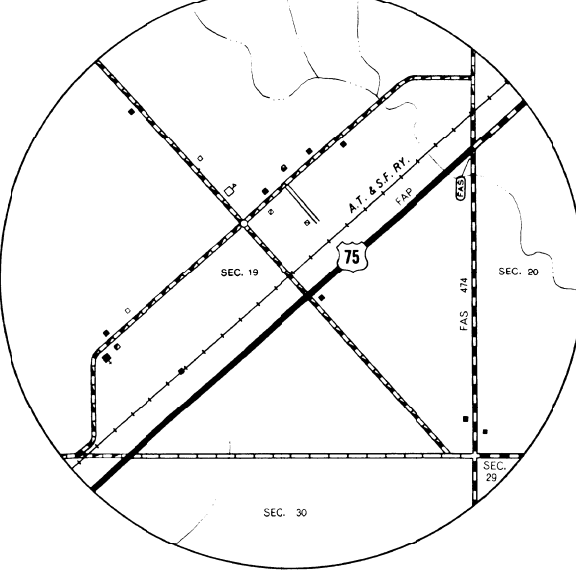

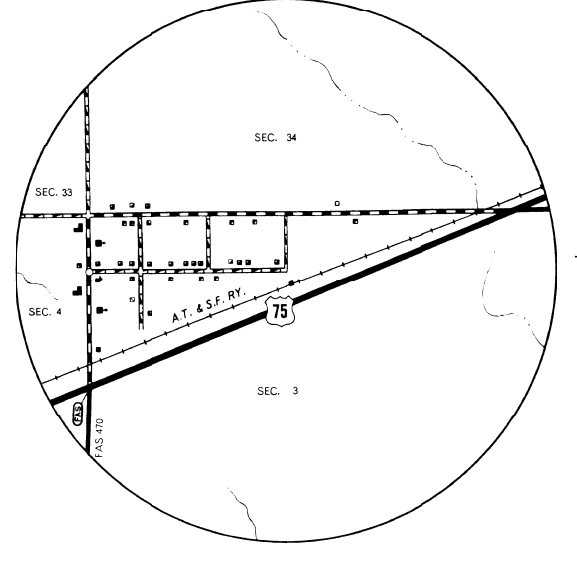

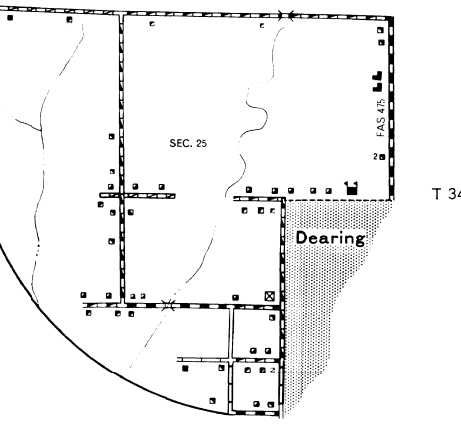

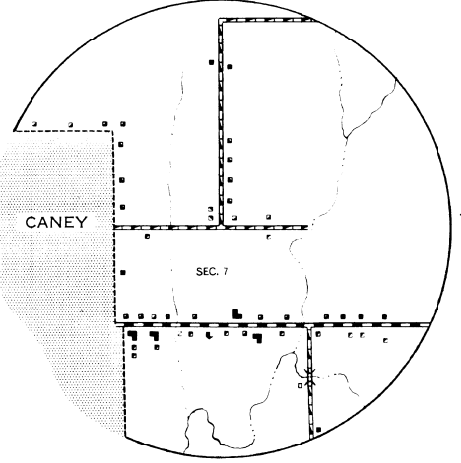

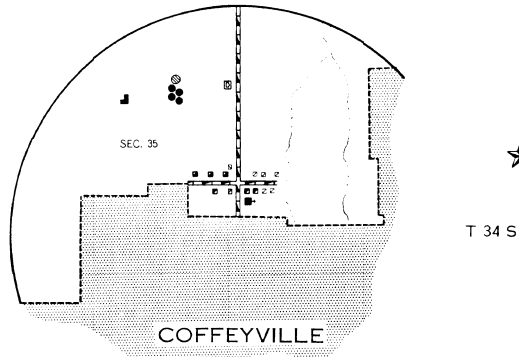
