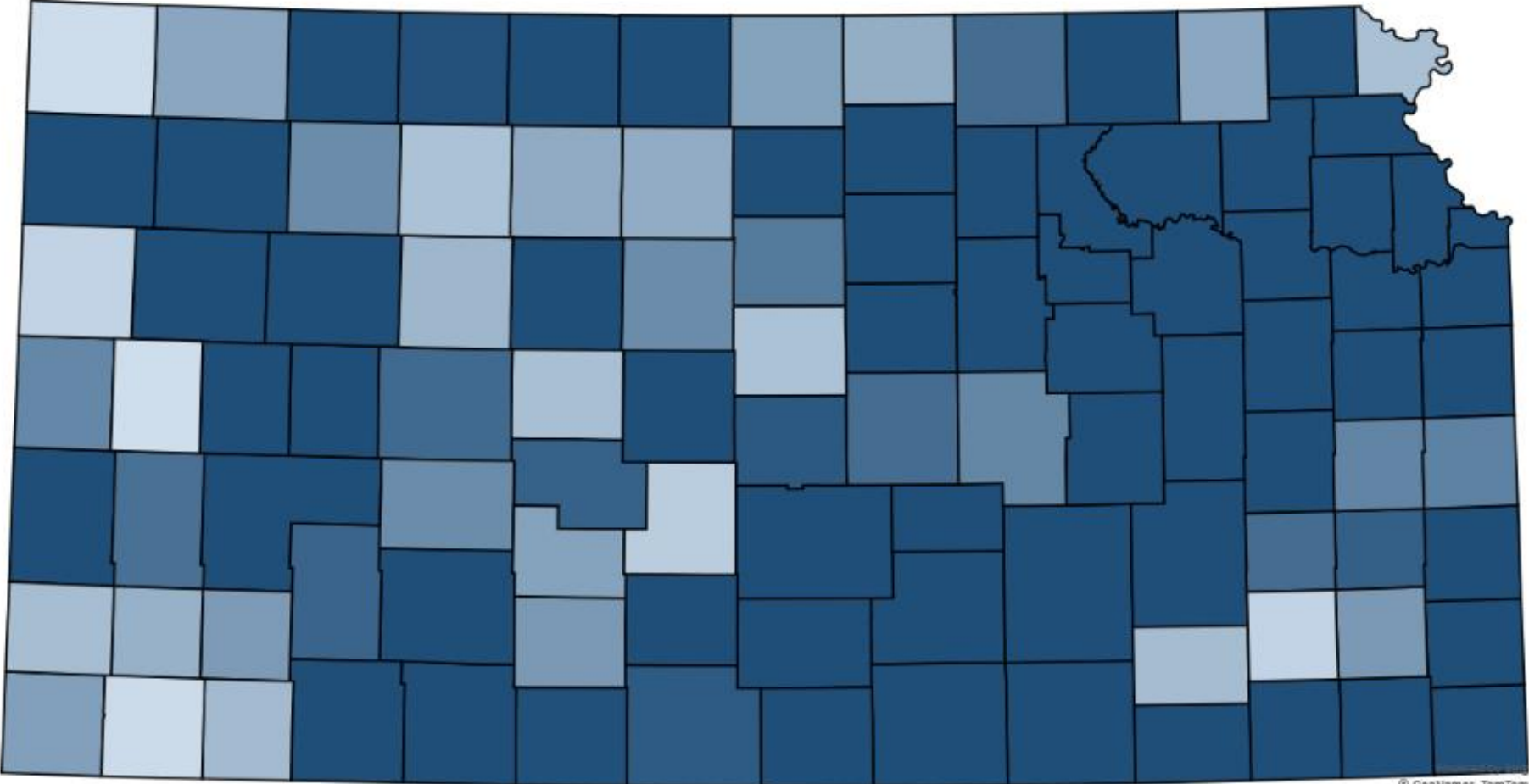

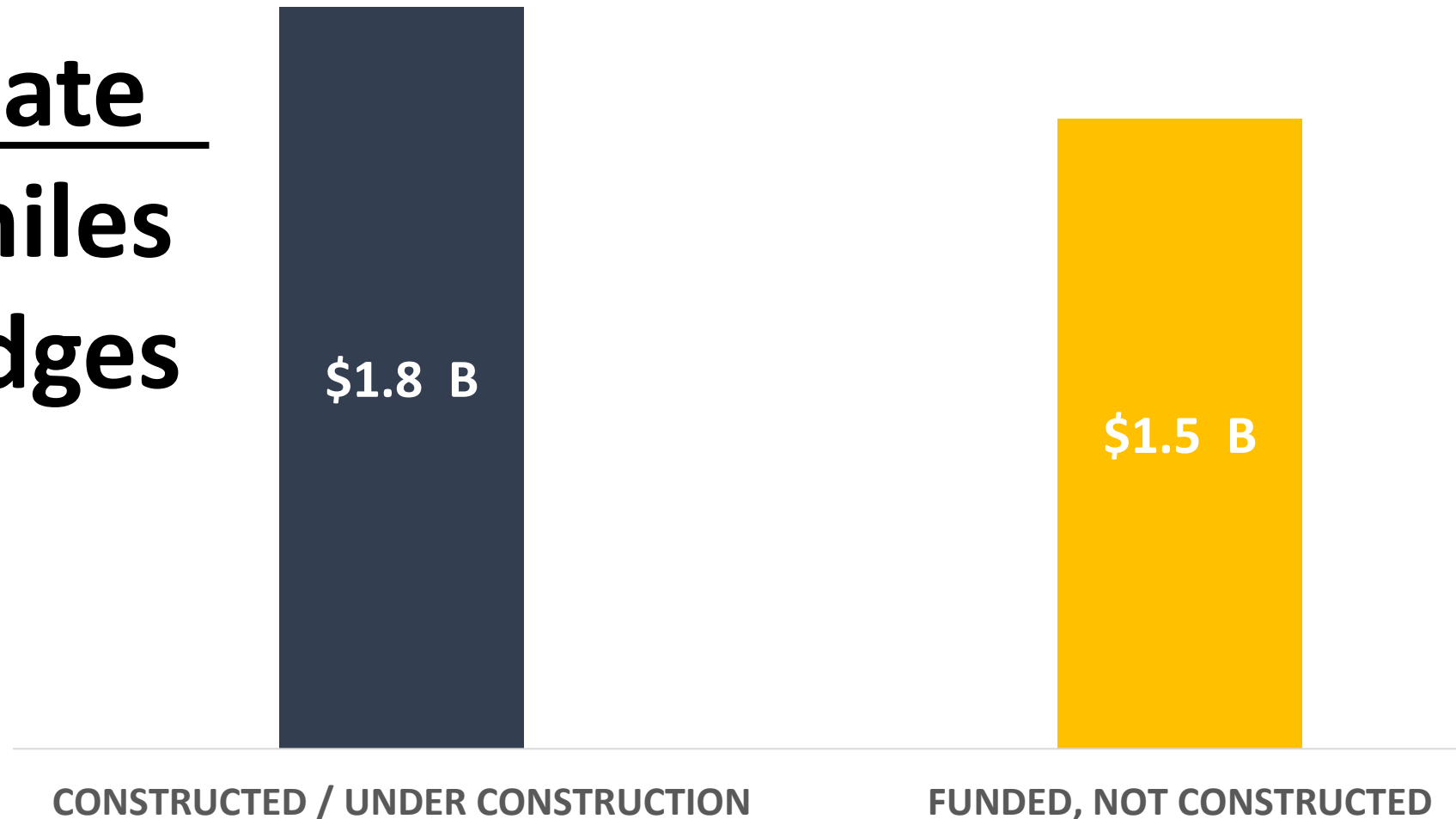

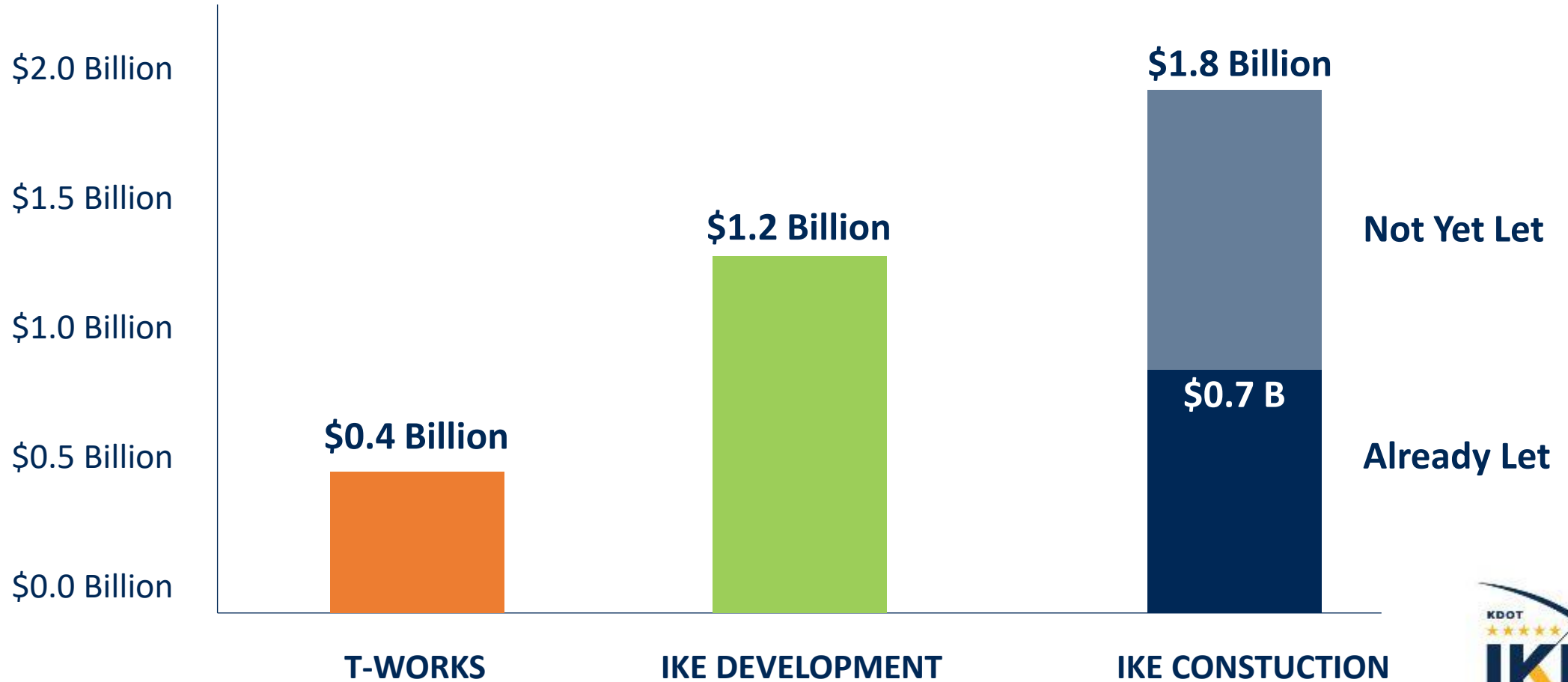

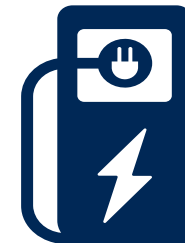

ELECTRIC CHARGING INFRASTRUCTURE

Charge Up Kansas NEVI Plan has been approved and is set to receive **\$39.5 million** total over the **next five years** under the National Electric Vehicle Infrastructure (NEVI) Formula Program. The funds will provide charging access to 1,600 miles of Kansas highways.

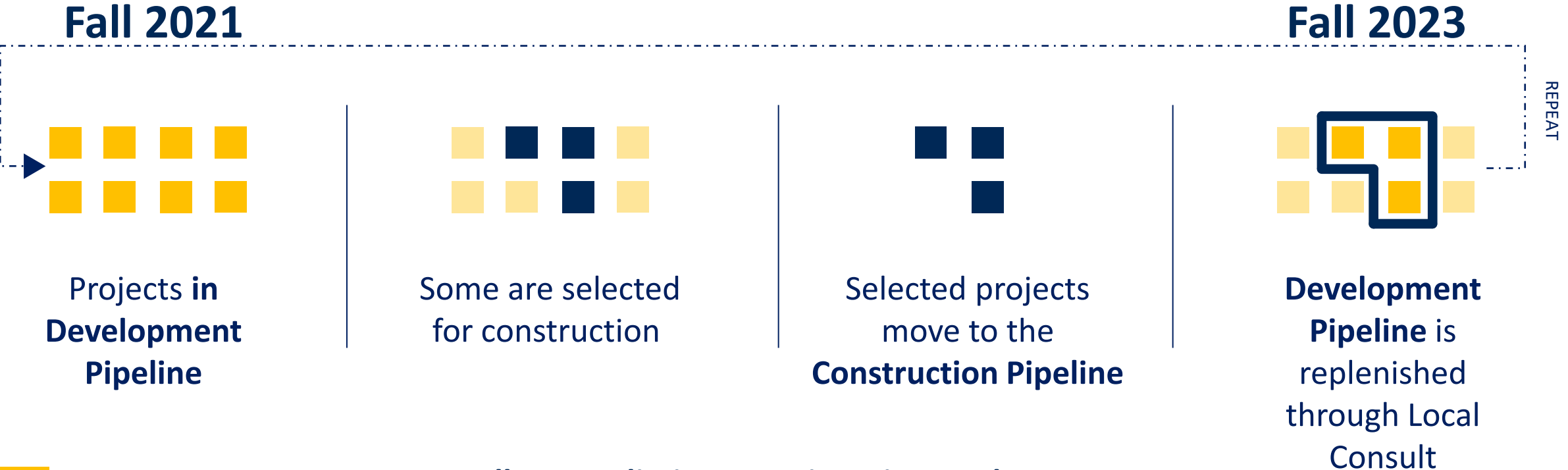
